

## Listening and attention



30-50 months 40-60+ months

• Single-channelled attention - can shift to a different task if attention fully obtained (using child's name helps focus).

· Able to follow directions.

 Maintain attention, concentrate and sit quietly during appropriate activity.

### Early Learning Goal

Children listen attentively in a range of situations. They listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events and respond to what they hear with relevant comments, questions or actions. They give their attention to what others say and respond appropriately, while engaged in another activity.

## **Understanding**



22 - 36months 30-50 months 40-60+ months

- Identify action words by pointing to the right picture.
- Understand more complex sentences.
- Understand use of objects.
- Show understanding of prepositions such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind' by carrying out an action or selecting correct picture.
- Respond to simple instructions.

- Respond to instructions involving a two-part sequence.
- Able to follow a story without pictures or props.


Answer 'how' questions about events

- · Understand 'who', 'what', 'where' in simple questions.
- Developing an understanding of simple concepts.
- Begin to understand 'why' and 'how' questions.
- Listen and respond to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion.

#### Early Learning Goal

Children follow instructions involving several ideas or actions. They answer 'how' and 'why' questions about their experiences and in response to stories or events.

## **Speaking**



Children express themselves effectively, showing awareness of listeners' needs. They use past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future. They develop their own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events.
